Sweet Surrender

Luke 9:57-62

Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ

- Savior: He saved me (eternal life)
- Lord: He owns me (my heart and life)
- Jesus must be both!

Surrender (Lordship)

1. Surrender is accepting the sovereignty of God
2. "God is either Lord of all or He is not Lord at all.
(Lordship Law #1)

Three Men – Three Lessons

1. Accepting the future regardless of the cost.
2. Leaving the past regardless of the pull.
3. Seizing the moment regardless of the sacrifice.
4. Other Observations
 - Not everyone is ready to surrender.
 - Surrendering is more than words.
 - Jesus knows our heart.
 - Surrender means change.

Going Deeper

We encourage you to get into God's word this week. Below is a daily reading plan to help you read the Bible each day and learn more about today's message. This short investment of time will pay off huge dividends in your knowledge of God's Word and your relationship with God.

With the 100 Day Adventure starting next week, our Digging Deeper is based around the importance of God's Word.

Day 1: Psalm 119:1-11

- How does God's Word help us with sin (vs.11)? How does God respond to those who do what's right?

Day 2: Matthew 4:1-11

- Jesus used God's Word to be faithful to God. What are some practical ways God's Word can be used in our lives?

Day 3: Romans 10:11-17

- Why is God's Word so important? What important role do you play in sharing it with others?

Day 4: Psalm 119:105-112

- How does God give us direction (a "light") through his Word? Why is his Word important?

Day 5: Joshua 1:1-9

- What important things do you learn here about God's Word ("Book of the Law")?

Day 6: Romans 15:1-6

- Why do we have God's Word and what does it offer us (vs. 4)?

Day 7: John 8:1-47

- (vs. 31-32) What does obedience to God's Word provide? Why is it important that I hear from God (His Word)?
