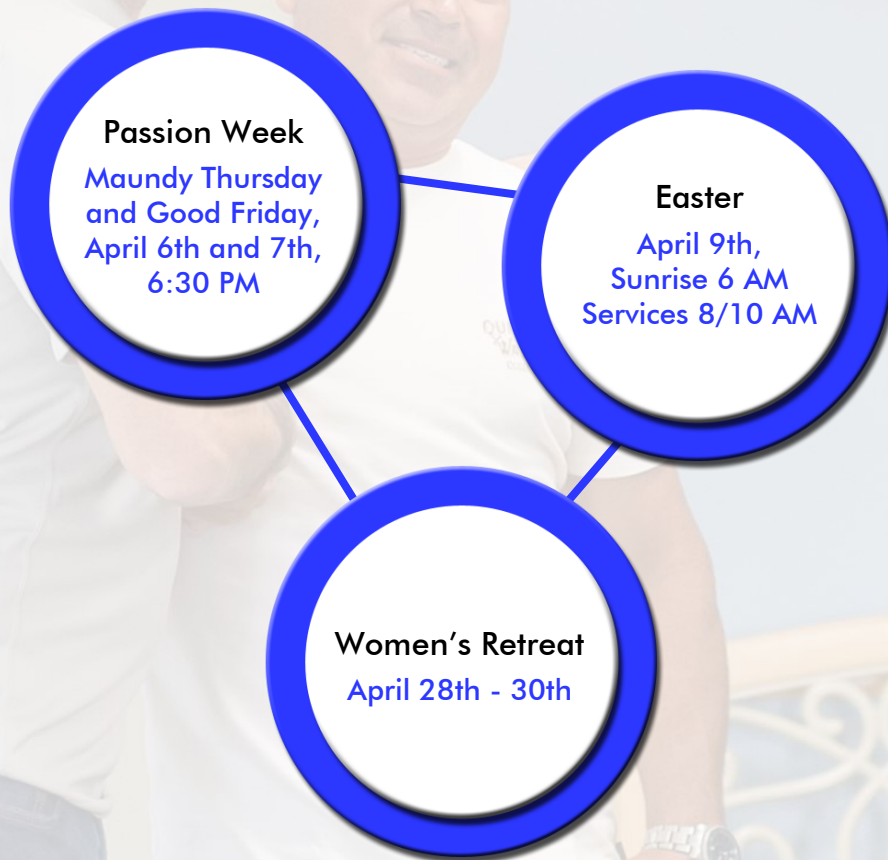

Easter

- **Easter Schedule:** This year's Easter schedule starts with Maundy Thursday (communion) Service on Thursday night at 6:30 PM. Then on Friday will be Good Friday (experiential) Service at 6:30 PM. Then Easter Sunday will start with Sunrise Service at 6:00 AM followed by breakfast and then two identical Worship Services (8:00 AM and 10:00 AM). In between the two services, we will have an Easter Egg Hunt at 9:30 AM for our children.
