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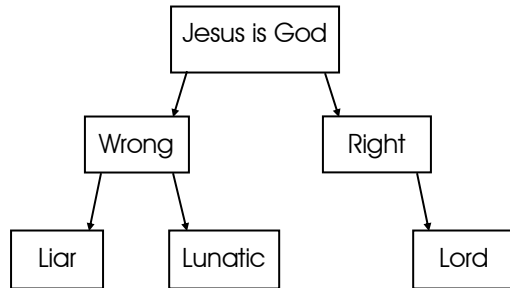
# WHO IS JESUS?

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John 3:1-21



### Say What?

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## Going Deeper

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We encourage you to get into God's word this week. Below is a daily reading plan to help you read the Bible each day and learn more about today's message. This short investment of time will pay off huge dividends in your knowledge of God's Word and your relationship with God. Below each reading is a question or two to reflect on throughout your day. If you are journaling you can write down your response and whatever else you got out of it (e.g. what the Holy Spirit is telling you).

### Day 1: John 3:1-21

Our sermon text...review your sermon notes. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you one day later?

### Day 2: John 11:25-27

(From our message two weeks ago) What does Jesus say before he raises Lazarus from the dead? How does this statement reflect on Jesus being God incarnate (God in the flesh)

### Day 3: John 14:1-6

Meditate on Jesus being the only way to God (the Father). Do you really believe it's true? How do you respond to someone who thinks differently?

### Day 4: Acts 2:14-41 (esp. 2:14, 22-24, 37-41)

Notice that after hearing about Jesus a response was necessary (vs. 37). When did you respond to Jesus? When was the last time you shared Jesus with someone?

### Day 5: John 1:1-18 ("Word" = Jesus)

What are some facts listed here about Jesus that are only true of Him? How does it fit in the "Liar, Lunatic, Lord" discussion we've been teaching?

### Day 6: James 2:14-19

What is the relationship of faith and believing? Is your faith like that described here? How is it and how is it not?

### Day 7: Matthew 3:1-6

What was the message of John the Baptist? Does it still apply today? How could you be more like John the Baptist?
