Going Deeper

We encourage you to get into God's word this week. Below is a daily reading plan to help you read the Bible each day and learn more about today's message. This short investment of time will pay off huge dividends in your knowledge of God's Word and your relationship with God.

Below each reading is a question or two to reflect on throughout your day. If you are journaling you can write down your response and whatever else you got out of it (e.g. what the Holy Spirit is telling you).

Day 1: 1 John 2:28-3:10

- In your journal, make a list of which verses refer to each of these themes...Christ's return...Abiding in Christ...The love of God...God's Children...Born again...Sin and righteousness...Evidence of our Salvation.

Day 2: Matthew 24:3-31

- Did Jesus leave any doubt in the disciples' minds that he would be coming back?

Day 3: Matthew 24:32-51

- When you plan out your day, do you consider that *THIS* could be *THE DAY*? What do you want Jesus to "catch" you doing when He returns?

Day 4: Matthew 25:1-46

- What is the main point of each parable? How will this affect the way you spend your time and your treasure today?

Day 5: Titus 1:1-16

- Are the qualifications for church leaders any different than the exhortations that ALL Christians are to live by? What does verse 16 say about our talk and our walk?

Day 6: Titus 2:1-15

- What is your role in the family of God? What does it tell you about how you should act towards your church family?

Day 7: Titus 3:1-11

- How is your attitude toward those who are not part of our church family (unbelievers)? What do verse 4-8 say about our works and our salvation?
