Going Deeper

We encourage you to get into God's word this week. Below is a daily reading plan to help you read the Bible each day and learn more about today's message. This short investment of time will pay off huge dividends in your knowledge of God's Word and your relationship with God.

Below each reading is a question or two to reflect on throughout your day. If you are journaling you can write down your response and whatever else you got out of it (e.g. what the Holy Spirit is telling you).

Day 1: Luke 1:26-38

- Think of the different emotions Mary felt as she conversed with the angel and consider her final words (vs. 38). What is a lesson or two you can apply today?

Day 2: Luke 1:39-56

- This is the song we studied in Sunday's sermon. Reviewing what you learned, when is it easy for you to rejoice and when is it not?

Day 3: Luke 1:39-45

- What were the ladies excited about? Look carefully. Are you excited when you see the hand of God working? Do you rejoice and thank him?

Day 4: Genesis 12:1-3

- This is the promise Mary refers to in her song (Luke 1:54-55). What are some promises of God you can rejoice in today that you have seen happen in your own life? Pray that you can share one to someone today.

Day 5: Psalms 62:5-8

- Which part of this passage is easy for you and which part is hard? Where do you need to rest in the Lord instead of stressing out?

Day 6: Matthew 11:28-30 (Jesus speaking)

- Following up yesterday's verses, bring your burden(s) to God now and let him teach you and give you rest today.

Day 7: 1 Thessalonians 5:16 and Philippians 4:4
